I may not understand what you mean and I can have difficulty having a conversation. If I ignore you or interrupt, I don't mean to be rude, but I'm still learning how to do this.

I have very sensitive hearing to either loud or soft noises; it can really hurt my ears. I'm also sensitive to certain smells, taste and the way things feel. Sometimes I become anxious and stressed because my Autism just gets too much for me.

It would be great if you help me by saying my name "Stephen" before you start talking to me and don't talk too fast. Sometimes I just need to go to a quiet place for a few minutes. If I look like I'm a bit stressed, please can you help me.
